- Most recent and complete bank statement for the last 90 days.
- Proof of any additional assets.



I WANT TO GO TO THE DOCTOR. WHAT SHOULD I DO?

- Set up an appointment by calling your medical home.— your PCP.
- If you need transportation assistance, let your medical home know at the time you are scheduling the appointment.
- Remember, ONLY call the medical home listed on your Orange Card!



WHAT SHOULD I DO IF I GET SICK OR HURT?

- If you get sick or hurt, first call your medical home. The staff can tell you if you should:
 - Treat the problem at home
 - Come in to see the doctor
 - Go to an urgent care center
 - Go to the Emergency Department

WHAT IF I NEED SPECIALTY MEDICAL CARE?

- Your primary care doctor may refer you to a specialty care doctor to help with your care.
- Your primary care doctor will set up your appointment with the specialist.
- Please show your Orange Card and identification to the office staff at your specialty care doctor's office when you go for the appointment.
- Remember, ONLY your primary care doctor can make your appointment to a specialist! You will be held responsible to cover the costs if you make your own specialty care appointment!



WHAT IF I NEED DENTAL CARE?

- Enroll in Guilford Community Care Network
- Make an appointment with your PCP (medical home) to get a referral to our dental clinic, the Guilford Dental Access Program (GDAP).
- The dental clinic will call you to make an appointment after they receive your PCP's referral.
- GDAP offers cleanings, x-rays, fillings, can pull teeth, dentures/flippers and provide other urgent dental care services as needed.
- There is a \$30 cash co-pay for each visit.

HOW DO I GET MY MEDICATION?

- Present your Orange Card and identification at your medical home pharmacy.
- Your co-pay for medicines is listed on your Orange Card.
- If your medical home does not have a pharmacy, you may get your medication at:
