WHAT THE ORANGE CARD MEANS FOR GUILFORD COUNTY RESIDENTS



The Guilford Community Care Network's Orange Card program is once again in the spotlight thanks to an NC Health News feature this month examining Guilford County's health care safety net for uninsured residents.

The story highlights how **GCCN's Orange Card has helped more than 62,000 local residents access medical, dental and specialty care since 2002**, particularly as new Medicaid work requirements threaten coverage for thousands across North Carolina. Executive Director Sarah Dison (left) discusses the growing need for the program and the community partnerships helping uninsured residents navigate health care access, transportation and food insecurity. The article also explores how Guilford County organizations are preparing for an expected increase in demand for services in the coming years.
